Pending before the Court is the Plaintiff's Verified Complaint and Application for Temporary Restraining Order, Injunctive Relief, Enforcement of Public Health Laws, and for Order to Show Cause, filed 10/22/2020. The Plaintiff alleges the Defendant is not operating in compliance with the statewide "Mask Directive" issued by the Governor on July 15, 2020. The Plaintiff has requested the Court issue a temporary restraining order, without notice to the Defendant, enjoining the Defendant from:

operating in a manner contrary to the emergency directives and Department's public health orders. Specifically, but not limited to, the Department requests a temporary restraining order enjoining Defendant from operating in violation of the Mask Directive . . . An order directing the Flathead County Sheriff's Office to enforce the terms and conditions of the . . . temporary restraining order.

The Plaintiff's *Application for Temporary Restraining Order* is DENIED pursuant to Mont. Code Ann. §27-19-315.

This matter is set for a Preliminary Injunction Hearing on November 2, 2020, at 1:30 p.m. The Plaintiff shall immediately serve a copy of this *Order* and the *Verified Complaint and Application for Temporary Restraining Order, Injunctive Relief, Enforcement of Public Health Laws, and for Order to Show Cause* upon the Defendant consistent with Rule 4, Mont.R.Civ.P.
