AHNER, a person of lawful age, being first duly 19 sworn upon his oath, deposes and says: 20 Affiant is a Deputy County Attorney for Flathead County, 21 As such, Affiant is empowered to initiate and 22 prosecute persons charged with crimes committed in the State of 23 Montana and to initiate such prosecutions by Information filed 24 in District Court. 25 Pursuant to Section 46-11-201, MCA, Affiant seeks leave to 26 file an Information charging the Defendant with the offense of 27 DELIBERATE HOMICIDE, a felony. More specifically, that charge 28

would allege the following:

The Defendant, TANNER HOSEK, on or about July 9, 2018, in Flathead County, Montana, purposely or knowingly caused the death of another human being by stabbing his Erik Hosek, his father, with a knife, contrary to the provisions of § 45-5-102(1), MCA, and punishable under the provisions of § 45-5-102(2), MCA, by death as provided in §§ 46-18-301 through 46-18-310, MCA, life imprisonment, or by a term in the state prison of not less than 10 years or more than 100 years. Because a dangerous weapon was used in the commission of this offense, under the provisions of § 46-18-221(1), MCA, this offense is punishable by an additional term in the state prison of not less than 2 years or more than 10 years.

As reported by the Flathead County Sheriff's Office (FCSO), the facts establishing probable cause to believe that the Defendant has committed the foregoing offenses are as follows:

On July 9, 2018, officers with the Flathead County Sheriff's Office responded to a residence outside of Whitefish in Flathead County after receiving a report of an altercation. Officers arrived and found Eric Hosek deceased. TANNER HOSEK admitted that he had stabbed and killed his father.
