The undersigned states that on or about the date(s) hereinafter set forth, in the County of Flathead, State of Montana, the above named Defendant did commit the offenses of Count I: Assault, a Misdemeanor, OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE Count II: Assault, a Misdemeanor.

COUNT I: Assault, Misdemeanor

The Defendant, ANDY MAHERAS, on or about August 31, 2023, in Flathead County, Montana, purposely or knowingly caused reasonable apprehension of bodily injury in another, contrary to the provisions of §45-5-201(1)(d), and punishable under the provisions of § 45-5-201(2) MCA, by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed six (6) months and/or by a maximum fine of \$500.

OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE

COUNT II: Assault, Misdemeanor

The Defendant, ANDY MAHERAS, on or about August 31, 2023, in Flathead County, Montana, purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to another, contrary to the provisions of \$45-5-201(1)(a), and punishable under the provisions of \$45-5-201(2) MCA, by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed six (6) months and/or by a maximum fine of \$500.

- 1. As reported by Geno Cook with the Flathead County Sheriffs Office in Flathead County Sheriff's Office report number 2023-35154, the facts establishing probable cause to believe the Defendant had committed the foregoing offenses On or about 09/25/2023 Helena Flats are as follows: 1. School Superintendent, ANDY MAHERAS, messaged School Resource Officer and Flathead County Sheriff's Deputy Geno Cook asking if he could stop by as he had an issue and Deputy Cook met with MAHERAS in his needed help with it. office and he explained on 08/31/2023, he was trying to admonishing two students, T.R. (12) and another 13 year old girl for what he thought was a public display of affection (kissing) in the hall. MAHERAS stated T.R. attempted to walk away from him so he grabbed his arm. MAHERAS stated T.R. was now claiming MAHERAS had grabbed his face and pushed him into a locker. MAHERAS stated he remembered grabbing onto T.R. when he tried walking away, however he didn't remember if he pushed him into the locker and grabbed his face.
- 2. On or about 10/10/23, Detective Carey was assigned to the case for further investigation. Detective Carey reviewed the video he obtained from the school and statements supplied by Helena Flats School Principal Allison Hawes and school counselor William Walker. In the video, Detective Carey characterizes observing the following events unfold: School Superintendent MAHERAS can be clearly seen grabbing T.R. by the left arm, pulling him towards him and then placing his left hand on T.R.'s back and speaks to him. T.R. can be seen turning away from MAHERAS and MAHERAS grabs T.R. by the left shoulder with his arm behind T.R.'s back, in a side hug type position. MAHERAS removes his arm and T.R. can be seen walking away towards what appear to be lockers. MAHERAS can be seen turning in the same direction as T.R. and shaking his head.

MAHERAS can then be seen walking towards the same area as T.R. did and goes off camera. While off camera, several kids can be seen reacting to something going on in the direction T.R. and MAHERAS had gone off camera, a few looked surprised and some walking by the area in the hall can be seen turning to look and watch what was happening. Near the end of the video, MAHERAS can be seen coming back into partial camera view and walks off out of camera view as a locker gets closed in the same area.

On or about 10/12/23, T.R. went in for a forensic T.R. reported on 8/31/2023 MAHERAS had interview. approached him and a female and accused them of kissing in the hallway. T.R. reported MAHERAS had grabbed him by the arm and spoke to him about what he observed. As T.R. was walking away to go to his locker to get a pencil, he reported MAHERAS grabbed him by the arm again and then by both arms squeezing them and pushed him into the lockers. He said he did not want to look at MAHERAS, saying he was scared of him, and MAHERAS grabbed his chin and squeezed his face turning it towards MAHERAS. T.R. described the squeezing of his face to be like if you were squeezing a stress ball and it hurt. He also reported that when MAHERAS turned his head after grabbing his face, his neck popped which also hurt.
